NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST AUGUST 2016

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

1.2 Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the Income and Expenditure Account when the association is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

1.3 Resources expended

All expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis, including value added tax which is irrecoverable, and has been included under expense categories.

1.4 Freehold Property

Freehold property is stated at cost at the balance sheet date. No depreciation has been provided (see 2 below).

1.5 Leasehold Property

Leasehold property held as an investment is stated at fair value. Revaluation surpluses or deficits are transferred to a revaluation reserve (see 4 below).

2 Freehold Property

The Whitgiftian Association is the proprietor of the clubhouse and playing fields at Croham Road, South Croydon, Surrey, which was acquired on 5th May 1950 at a cost of £4,700. Under the terms of the conveyance it can only be sold, at that price, to the Whitgift Foundation. Subsequent expenditure incurred has been included at cost. The freehold title is held, as Trustee, by Old Whitgiftian Trustees Limited. No depreciation has been provided.

3 Mortgage

The Freehold Property is mortgaged to the Whitgift Foundation by deed dated 2nd May 1963. There are no fixed repayment terms, interest being payable at the rate of 7% per annum. Movements were as follows:

5 Whitgiftian Association

Whitgiftian Association is an unincorporated association governed by its Constitution adopted 14th July 2012, wherein are set out the objects of the association.

6 Old Whitgiftian Trustees Limited

This company was formed on 26th January, 1944 and holds the freehold of the clubhouse and grounds at Croham Road and the lease for the flat in Spencer Road, South Croydon as Trustee for the Whitgiftian Association. It also holds the funds of the War Memorial Fund on behalf of the Whitgiftian Association. Directors of the company (appointed annually by the WA) are Chris Jenkins (Chairman), David Straw (Treasurer), Ian Flanagan, Nick Flood, Richard Blundell, Jon Bunn and Mike Irwin (deceased 2016),

7 Whitgiftian Association Trust (Charity Number: 1157289)

The trust was formed on 24th January 2012 "to further such purpose which may be charitable according to the law of England and Wales as the trustees see fit by the awarding of grants" The trustees are Ian Flanagan (Chairman), Mark Endersby (Secretary), Jonathan Bunn, Pip Burley, Alan Cowing, Nick Somers, David Stranack, and Stuart Woodrow. The sum of £5,000 was advanced to the trust to enable it to apply for charitable status. There are no fixed repayment terms, and the loan is free of interest. The trust was registered as a charity on 3rd June 2014. During the accounting period the Whitgiftian Association offset £375 of costs against the loan to the trust. As at 31st August 2016 the balance of the loan is £4,625. The Whitgift Foundation has advanced the sum of £10,000 to the Whitgiftian Association to support the Fundraising Administrator cost, of which £5,000 has been allocated during the accounting period.

8 Whitgift Sports Club Limited

The company, which is limited by guarantee, was formed on 16th August 2012 to take over the sporting and related activities of the Old Whitgiftian Association. The sole member of the company is Whitgiftian Association Trust. The directors are Alan Cowing (Chairman), Martin Ashby, Pip Burley, Keith Hopkins, Chris Jenkins (nominated by Old Whitgiftian Trustees Limited), James Stremes, and Richard Veldeman.

As the activities for which the company assumed responsibility were loss-making, the Whitgiftian Association recognised the need to provide financial support for a reasonable period of time and this has been set out in a Letter of Understanding dated 1st September 2012.

This provides, inter alia, for the provision of funds by the Whitgiftian Association to Whitgift Sports Club Limited for a period of five years commencing in the 2012-2013 financial year. There are no fixed repayment terms and the loan is free of interest. In view of the foreseeable financial position of Whitgift Sports Club Limited, full provision against the loan has been made. 13 Advance Membership Scheme

The scheme enables present pupils of the school to obtain membership of the Whitgiftian Association for seven years after leaving school by payment in advance at reduced rates. Fifteen termly payments are made over a period of five years by parents taking advantage of the scheme.

This is a change from previous years, when amounts were transferred to and from reserves.
